Thank you for your interest in the Dance Holidays for children and young people at Schloss Blumenthal. On this sheet you will find some further information about the course, its content, length of sessions as well as anything else we thought you might want to know.

Sessions we are offering:

All classes are levelled and participants attend classes suitable to their ability and age. Classes for younger students are 60 mins, classes for older students are 90 mins.

ALL Students will take part in

Classical Ballet (1.5h per day) taught by Roselinde Fock-Nüzel.

Modern/ Contemporary (1.5h per day) teacher to be confirmed

Then ALL students can choose from a variety of sessions including Classical Repertory, Intensive RAD Coaching Sessions, Hip Hop, Pilates and Parkour.

A detailed timetable will be sent out in April.

Around the classes we are offering a variety of arts and craft activities, daily swimming in the nearby lakes, evening bonfires, treasure hunts, nighttime walks plus lots more announced at a later date.

Accommodation:

All children will be accommodated in beautiful dormitories in the converted castle and stables.

In Blumenthal there is little mobile connection, so please do not be disappointed if you do not receive regular messages from your child during the week. Structure, free time, timetable:

The weekend will start on Sunday the 29th at 18:00h, we will have dinner together at about 19h. The weekend will end on Friday the 4th of August with a final performance at around 21:30h.

The children will have up to 6 hours of training per day in Ballet, Modern/Contemporary and introductory classes in other performance arts and physical trainings like Yoga or Pilates. The day will always start with a joint warm up for all. A precise timetable will be send to participants a few weeks before the Holidays. During leisure time, the children will be looked after by our lovely team of chaperones. They will do handicrafts with natural materials, play games, read, swim and spend the evenings around a bonfire or with treasure hunts and nightwalks.

The Final Performance:

All parents, brothers and sisters, friends and relatives are invited to come to our final performance on Friday 4th August which will start at 19:30h in and around the castle Blumenthal. (The performance is free)

Meals:

We are providing 3 fully organic meals a day as well as refreshments and snacks throughout the day. All food is sourced locally, primarily from Blumenthal's own land, fields and trees. We really want all children to eat well and healthily during their holidays. In case children still want to bring their own snacks - nuts, cereal bars and dried fruit are better than sweets. There are no shops at walking distance from Blumenthal.

What to bring:

Please make sure that you bring comfortable clothes that you can train and move in as well as trainers and outdoor shoes for walks. There is a small lake not far from the castle, so please bring swimming costumes if you would like to swim. Please bring towels and bedding. Please remember that the weather in Germany can be wet sometimes even during the summer....

How to get there:
